School support requests

- Not a support request, but a suggestion: KTR as a possible fundraiser just opened last year (on Eliott and 51st)
 - o Nicole sent the flyer to Prameela.
 - Similar to restaurant night we advertise, get 15% of sales.
- Poetry Contest Gift Cards
 - NHS is doing poetry contest, but are out of funds.
 - Request to Boosters to sponsor three \$25 Amazon gift cards. Request passed unanimously. Prameela will purchase and give them to Nicole (need by Feb 5th)
- BASIS Idol gift cards
 - Talent show in March.
 - Request to Boosters to sponsor 3 Amazon gift cards (\$25, \$15, and \$10), plus around
 \$30 for award trophies.
 - o Request passed unanimously. Prameela will purchase and give to Nicole.
- Funding for Murals.
 - Don't have a final cost, but are estimating around \$200 300. Will know more in January.
 - Don't want to set a precedent of funding clubs. Board agreed to provide this as "seed" money to get this started.
 - o Request passed, with stipulation that won't be funded next year.
